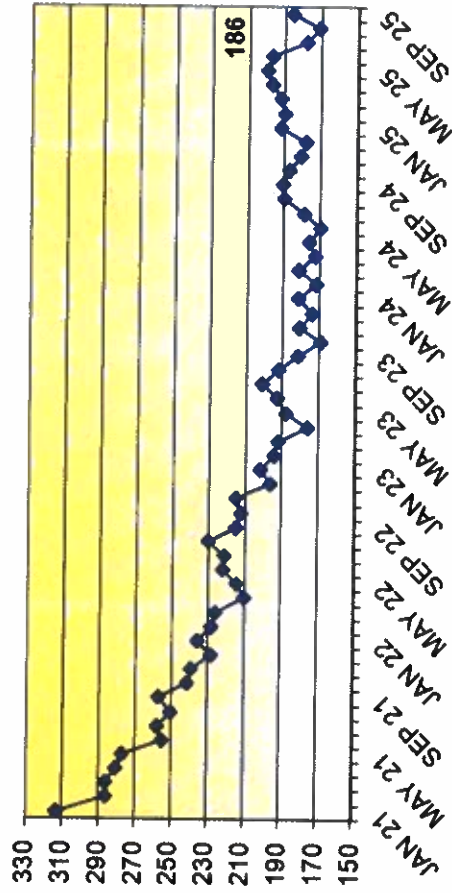

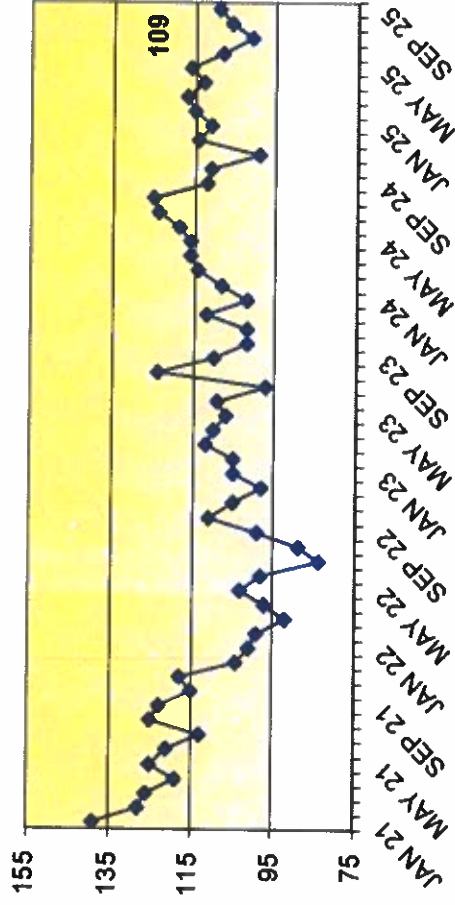

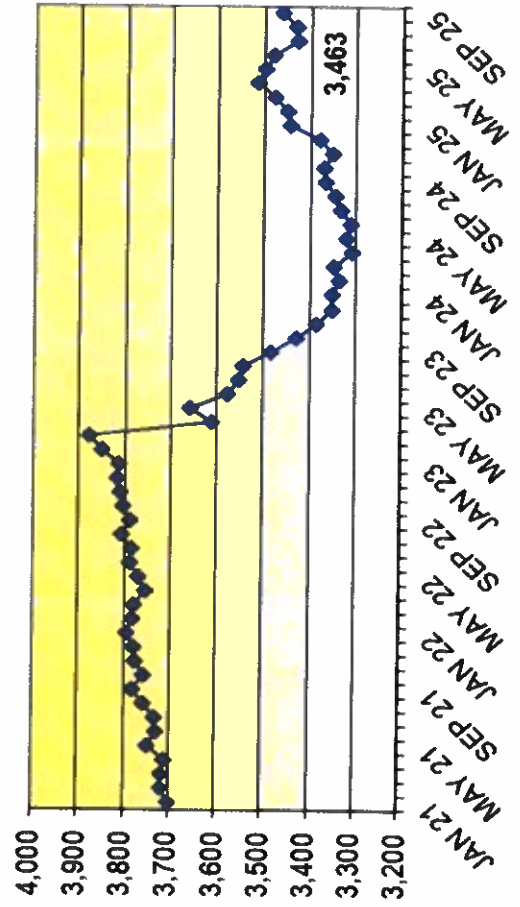
Total Family Assistance Recipients
Jan. 2021 - Sept. 2025



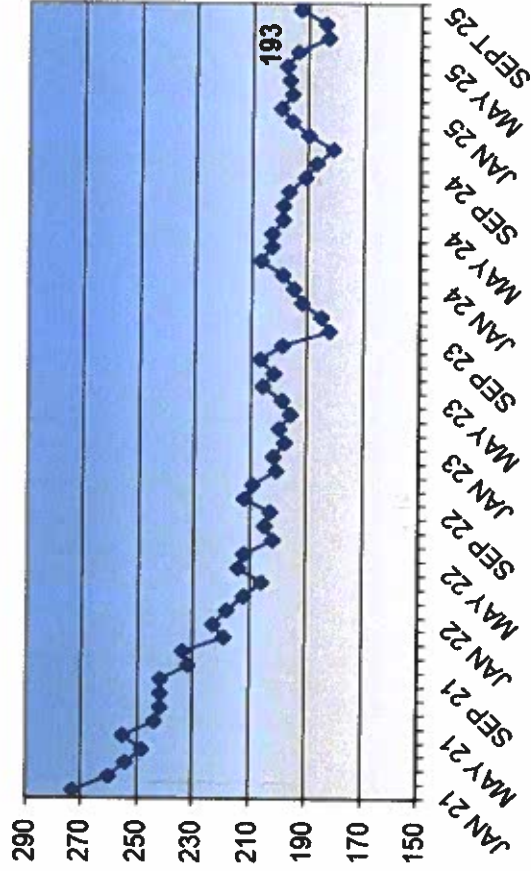

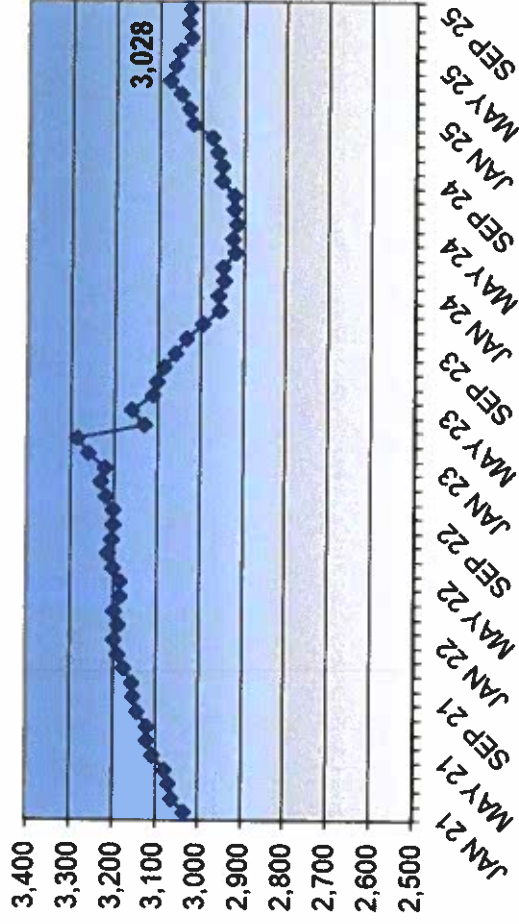

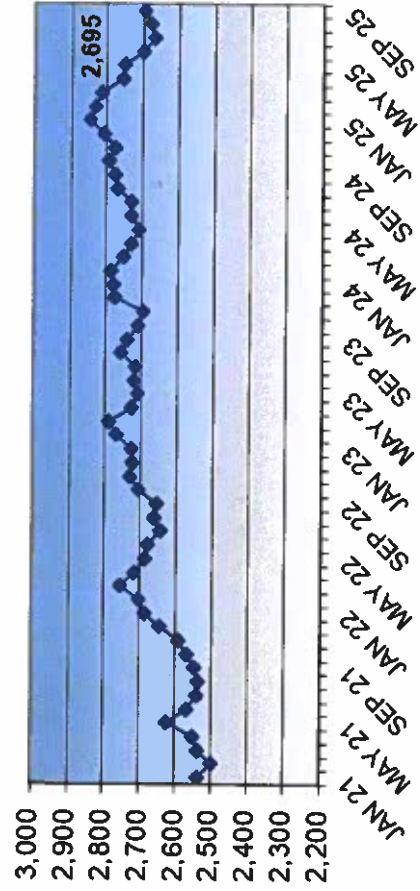
Temporary Assistance Caseload

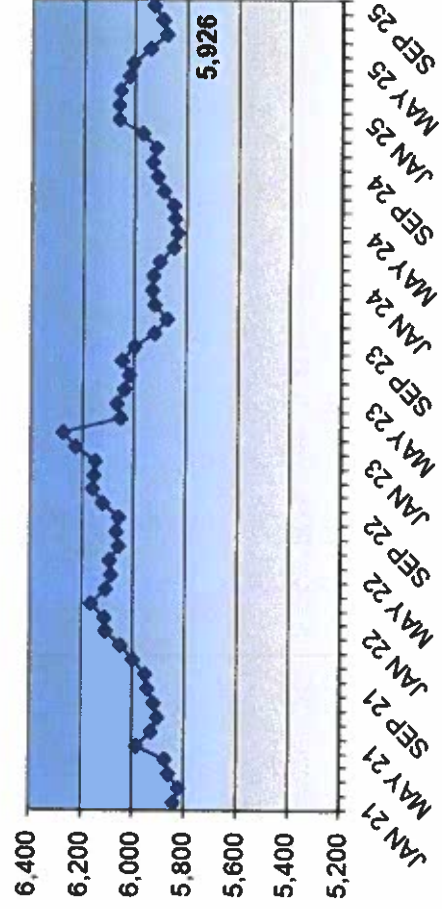
Total Medicaid Caseload

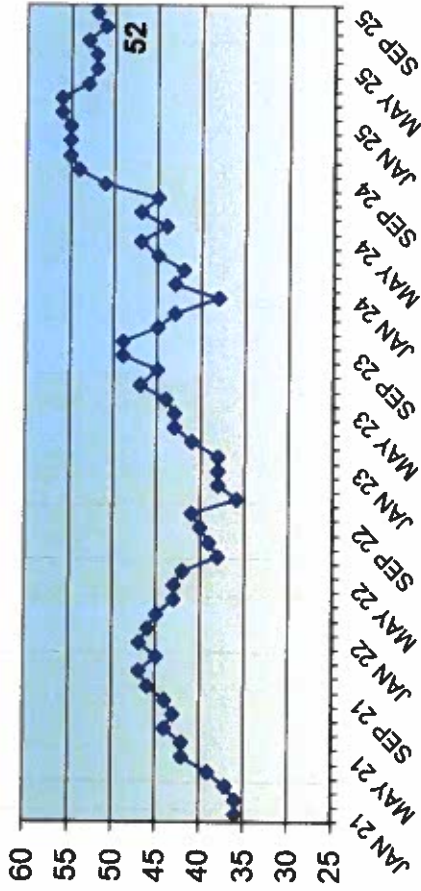
Total SNAP Caseload

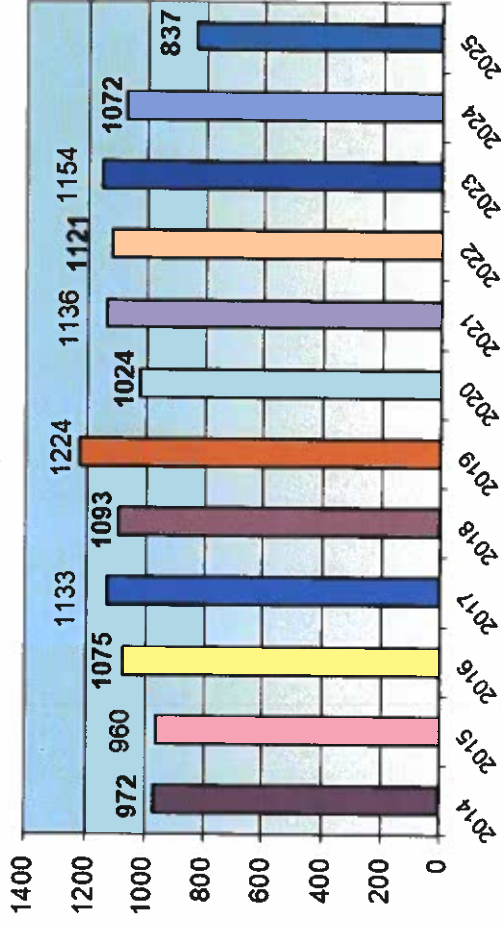
Total Transitional Supports Caseload

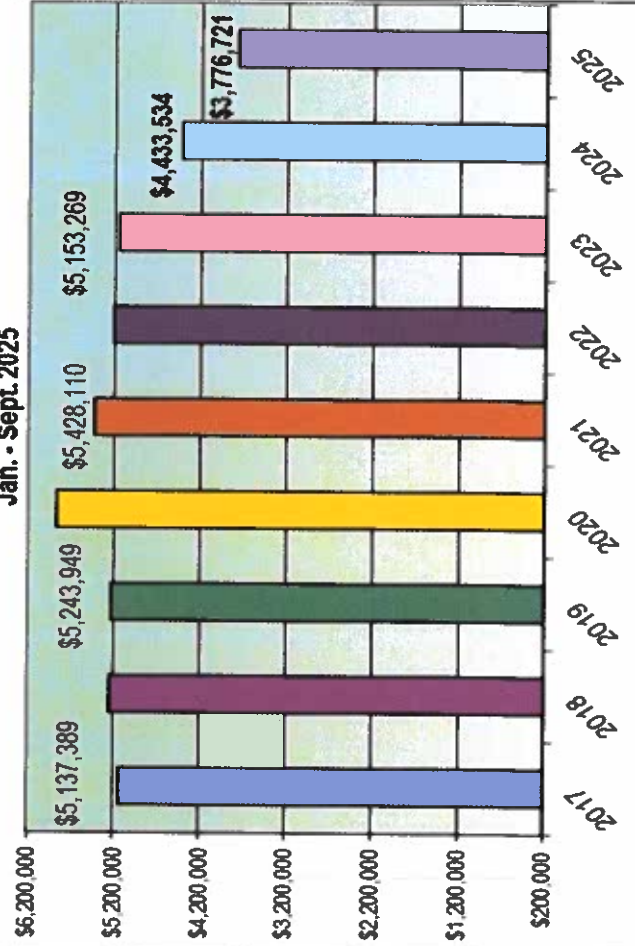

The Career Center has been especially busy supporting businesses, and customers preparing for upcoming layoffs, providing critical job search assistance during a challenging time. At the same time, the team is addressing severe budget cuts and working hard to maintain essential services in Tioga County. Ongoing conversations with the Broome County Career Center Director are focused on finding collaborative solutions to sustain support for the community.

Staff are also assisting 20 DSS-referred customers, with one recently securing employment. Additionally, due to scheduling conflicts with another regional event, the Tioga County Job Fair has been moved to November to allow for stronger employer participation and better opportunities for job seekers.
