



Dear Operator,

Tioga County Public Health and the Board of Health require all annual and seasonal food service establishments to have at least **one person on duty with an up-to-date Tioga County Food Course or ServSafe certification while in operation.**

Those who opt to take the Tioga County Food Course and pass the test will be issued a red certification card valid for two years. If you have a ServSafe certification, refer to the certification period set by ServSafe.

Certification cards and/or documentation must be kept at the establishment to verify course completion.

Anyone wishing to enroll in the Tioga County Food Course must complete an application and return it to Tioga County Public Health. There is no fee. Please find enclosed the food course application for your convenience. Each person will receive a **Personal Code Number by email** to access the Food Course Quiz.

All applications must be submitted to Tioga County Public Health, 1062 State Route 38, P.O. Box 120, Owego, New York 13827.
